

This term our theme is 'Victorious Victorians', which is a History based topic focusing particularly on the Industrial Revolution during the Victorian era. As part of our topic day the children will be learning about: industrial power, the industrial revolution (the six factors that led to it), impact on Burton and the local area and the impact on the rest of the world.



In maths this term, we will be studying fractions, decimals and percentages as well as ratio and proportion.



In English, the children will be studying the book Cogheart during their Guided Reading sessions. In writing, the children will complete various units and concentrate on their targets.
