**Positive**

- Your child must **self-isolate** for **10 days** from 1<sup>st</sup> day of symptoms.
- Everyone else in your household must **self-isolate** for **10 days** from 1<sup>st</sup> day of symptoms.
- The school will inform people who have been in close contact with your child and they will self-isolate for 10 days.

**Positive**

- Your child must **self-isolate** for **10 days** from 1<sup>st</sup> day of symptoms- if this date means they cannot return on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January inform school of absence in usual way
- Everyone else in your household must **self-isolate** for **10 days** from 1<sup>st</sup> day of symptoms.
- Anyone your child has had close contact with your child within 2 days of them developing the symptoms will self-isolate for 10 days.
