### Remote Learning



Dear Parents/Carers,

As we are now in a National Lockdown, we have moved to remote teaching and learning. Please refer to the two documents 'Remote Learning Policy Outwoods' and 'Remote Learning Contingency Plan 2020-21'.

Your child's class teacher will set work for the children in their classes, which will include any children in school i.e. critical worker and vulnerable children. Between 8:30am and 9:30am, the children will be given an activity to start the day, which will also include a time for registration via Zoom. This is a great way to start the day for the children, as it is a chance for them to see their teacher as well as their classmates. The timings for these are as follows:

**Year 6 and Reception** children to register at 8:30am (until 8:40am).

**Year 5** children to register at 8:40am (until 8:50am)

**Year 4** children to register at 8:50am (until 9:00am)

**Year 3** children to register at 9:00am (until 9:10am)

**Year 2 and Year 1** to register at 9:10am (until 9:20am)

**Nursery** to register at 9:20am (until 9:30am).

The structure of the day will follow a similar timetable for the class had they been in school. Teachers will be available between the hours of 9:30am – 11:30am and 1:30pm – 3:30pm in order to interact with the children or be available for questions. Work will be shared daily in a variety of ways including live lessons, pre-recorded videos, modelling, explanations and then children will be set activities to complete.

The timetable for the day will be shared with the children. It could look something like this:

8:30am – 9:30am	Registration
9:30am – 12:00pm (teachers available 9:30am – 11:30am)	Reading Writing Maths (Phonics for KS1) (Work to be submitted by 1:30pm for 'feedback and comments' to be given by 5pm. If there is a common issue then you might address this with the class the following day as you would with your distance marking).
